




Isabella bounced her tennis ball across the playground.


One bounce, two bounce, three bounce ...

"You can't," he said. "I lost one down there once. It had to stay there."





Ms Goldie was walking over to the staffroom.

Isabella looked down the hole. She felt very cross, but she needed to think. Soon she had an idea.




She ran to Mr Campbell's workshop. "Can I borrow a bucket?" she asked.
